- Aged 18+
- Living in County Durham
- Long term unemployed OR
- On Incapacity or other inactive benefits.

Priority will be given to beneficiaries who also:-

- Lack relevant up to date qualifications
- Lack key skills
- Have a history of short term unemployment
- Are returnees to the labour market
- Are part of a minority group

Right Step is not for beneficiaries who are participating in or eligible for existing New Deal or mainstream provision although the programme is open to those who have completed a New Deal Programme.

The Right Step Programme - support in a managed way.....

Each programme is individually tailored to the needs and desires of the participant who will engage in work experience whilst receiving intensive support.

The programme will provide an opportunity for those are not job-ready to acquire and update pre-vocational skills and increase knowledge and experience to facilitate re-entry into the labour market.

Intensive support will be provided to ensure that beneficiaries engage with and are sustained on programme. Support will address issues including confidence, motivation, esteem, social skills and anxiety around the return to work.

In addition, Right Step will access beneficiaries to other DISC Services to address issues around basic skills, benefits and money management, housing and accommodation advice,

substance misuse, mentoring, offending background.
